CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE CREEK, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 302.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41319. The date of priority is DECEMBER 6, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.75 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 275 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 22;

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 2590 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 22; AND

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 2750 FEET NORTH AND 1100 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0030 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537:260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

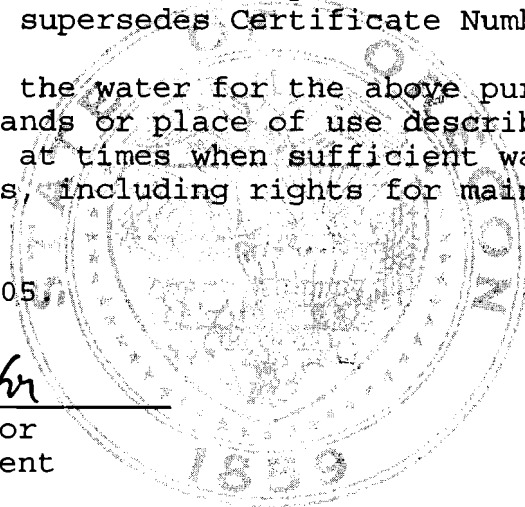
TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.
