CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

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confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK OF DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 18.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 10182. The date of priority is MAY 19, 1931. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN E. ROBBINS DLC 43, SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W. 1/2 1920 FEET NORTH AND 1950 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and

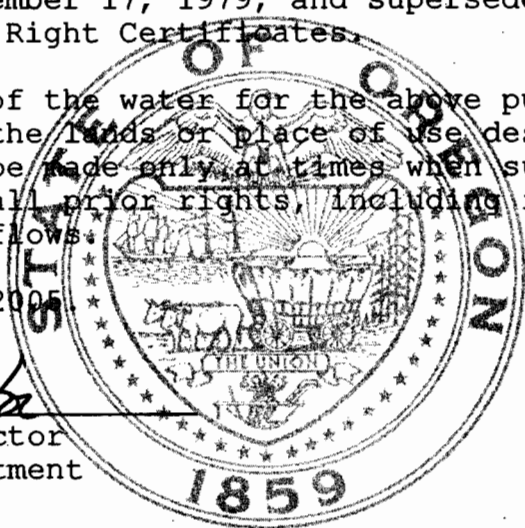
The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 17, 1979, and supersedes Certificate 11826, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
