CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FLORENCE JONES  
PAISLEY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of Chewaucan River, tributary of Abert Lake for irrigation of 393.6 acres, domestic and stock use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at page 1. The date of priority is 1878 under Proof No. 94.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1/25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.4 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season, being the period of April 1 to September 15 of each year; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.
