CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of Chewaucan River, tributary of Abert Lake for irrigation of 8.95 acres and domestic use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at page 3677. The date of priority is 1881 under Proof No. 129, and 1886 under Proof No. 131.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1/25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.9 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season, being the period of April 1 to September 15 of each year; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
