## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Rogue River, a tributary of the Pacific Ocean, for DOMESTIC, STOCK AND IRRIGATION of 5.4 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is September 22, 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.067 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

- LOT 7, (NE¼ NW¼), SECTION 6, T36S, R1W, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 13 (SE ¼ NW ¼) 0.6 ACRE LOT 9 (NE ¼ SW ¼) 4.8 ACRES SECTION 11 TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
