CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH FORK LAKE CREEK, a tributary of the METOLIUS RIVER, and a SPRING, for DOMESTIC USE (SWIMMING POOL ONLY).

This right was perfected under Permit S-23211. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, from North Fork Lake Creek when available, and any deficiency to be made up from the spring, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2007, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 1, 2005, approving Transfer Application 9793, and together with Certificate 81508, supersedes Certificate 23706, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
