This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1866.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five (5) acre-feet per acre for season, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
