Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.77 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 28837. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1963. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND [IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATED IN THE SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 2550 FEET SOUTH AND 2620 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14], or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 2620 FEET SOUTH AND 2560 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14; AND

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 2820 FEET SOUTH AND 2850 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 14, 1979, and, together with Certificates 49000 and 60004, supersedes Certificate 47058, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
