 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM and reservoir constructed under Application R-46013, Permit R-5472, a tributary of BEAVER CREEK, for STOCK USE and FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit 34367. The date of priority is May 5, 1969. The right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second (cfs); being 0.01 cfs for stock use and 0.01 cfs for fish culture, or the equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 41415, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 6, 2005, and recorded in Special Order Volume 67, Page 536, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 41415.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
