confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 15.60 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7614. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.193 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
