CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS IN THE SENESCHAL CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 4.7 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-460. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1957. The right is limited to not more than 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND [NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SENESCHAL DLC 59, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 607 FEET NORTH AND 812 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SENESCHAL DLC 59] or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1: NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SENESCHAL DLC 59, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 607 FEET NORTH AND 812 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SENESCHAL DLC 59.

WELL 2: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SENESCHAL DLC 59, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 1000 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.4 ACRES
SECTION 31
AS PROJECTED WITHIN SENESCHAL DLC 59

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.3 ACRES
SECTION 32
AS PROJECTED WITHIN SENESCHAL DLC 59
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.


When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 10, 1994 and together with Certificate 68376 supersedes Certificate 27819 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
