CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Dellmoor Cranberry Company
Warrenton, Oregon 97146

confirms the right to use the waters of Cullaby Creek, a tributary of Cullaby Lake, for flooding cranberry bogs on 72.76 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-9739. The date of priority is July 15, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 10.12 cubic feet per second, and shall be further limited to 6.0 acre feet per acre per year nor more than 0.75 acre foot per acre throughout any thirty day period, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 9733, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 18, 2006, approving Transfer Application 7747.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
