CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS and KAREN RUDOLPH
HCR 88 BOX 12
BAKER CITY OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 28.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume, 6 at Page 291. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.70 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

9 S	40 E	WM	9	SW NW	CORRAL DITCH - 50 FEET NORTH AND 2720 FEET EAST FROM THE C1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 73587, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 2007, approving Transfer Application T-8446.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other condition and limitations contained in said decree.
