## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER FROM THE POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 118.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 11973. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 21, 1935. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.96 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW3 NW3 and NW3 SW3 OF SECTION 17, NE3 and N2 SE3 OF SECTION 18, T 8 S, R 40 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 73522, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by a partial cancellation of a water right pursuant to the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 2007, approving Transfer Application T-8446.
