CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK A TETRAULT 2505 ROLLING LANE SOUTHLAKE, TEXAS 70051

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP POND; a tributary of BALDOCK SLOUGH, for IRRIGATION of 240.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3706. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.07 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO APPROPRIATION OF WATER ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT IT DOES NOT IMPAIR OR SUBSTANTIALLY INTERFERE WITH EXISTING SURFACE WATER RIGHTS OF OTHERS.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
