CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Janet Phillips 42047 Pocahontas Road Baker City, Oregon 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of a Sump Well in the Powder River Basin for Irrigation of 4.2 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3595. The date of priority is February 15, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 39 East, W.M.; 710 Feet South and 220 Feet East from the N¹/₄ Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ 2.7 Acres SW¼ NE¼ 1.5 Acres SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.
