CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 82.70 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4337. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 27, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.04 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate supersedes Certificate 42860.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
