

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

Confirms the right to use the waters of Little Creek, tributary to Catherine Creek, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of fish habitat.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6885. The date of priority is July 13, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.12 Cubic Foot per Second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from March 1 through October 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 5811, located at:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Survey Coordinates
4 S	39 E	WM	13	NE NW	Taylor Green Ditch – 1177 feet south and 50 feet west from the North ¼ corner of Section 13

To the mouth of Little Creek.


The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 5811, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 67, Page 790 approving Transfer 8058, and along with Certificate 81813 supersedes Certificate 5811, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This Certificate is being issued pursuant to Special Order Volume 67, Page 790.
