A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of HURRICANE CREEK AND SPRING CREEK, tributaries of the WALLOWA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 12.2 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WALLOWA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at Page 189. The date of priority is DECEMBER 22, 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

HURRICANE CREEK: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.; 2170 FEET NORTH AND 630 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 3.

SPRING CREEK: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.; 1650 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 3.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ 12.2 ACRES
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 14, 2002, and together with Certificate 79305, supersedes Certificate 3126, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices as approved by the Director for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
