CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C L PALMER
BAKER OR 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 14.55 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is DECEMBER 1, 1899.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to and amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
