CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

USDI, NATIONAL PARK SERVICE
JOHN DAY FOSSIL BEDS NATIONAL MONUMENT
HCR 82, BOX 126
KIMBERLY, OREGON 97848

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 35.67 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1386. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1912. The right is limited to not more than 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 12 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 1060 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM
THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install head gates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75793, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 1, 2006, approving Transfer Application 8683 for AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
