THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD DEMOSS ROUTE 3, BOX 3836 HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of a SUMP in the COLD SPRINGS WASH BASIN for IRRIGATION of 46.58 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7060. The date of priority is DECEMBER 22, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.58 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE¼ NE¼, SECTION 29, T 5 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1250 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE W¼ CORNER, SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ 15.30 ACRES SE¼ NW¼ 3.90 ACRES SECTION 28

SW¼ NE¼ 0.86 ACRE SE¼ NE¼ 26.52 ACRES SECTION 29 TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76378, State Record of
Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered May 30, 2006, approving Transfer Application 9685.
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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
