CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EDMUND H. DUYCK

HILLSBORO, OR 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 25.66 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50739. The date of priority is MAY 17, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; SOUTH 64 DEGREES 45 MINUTES EAST, 525 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF THE NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ OF SECTION 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, PROVIDED FURTHER WATER SHALL NOT BE APPROPRIATED DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 31 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ 5.56 ACRES
NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 9.10 ACRES
SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 8.52 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68690, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 24, 2006, approving Transfer Application T-9841.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
