

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by the Stipulation and Order signed on February 9, 2006 by Judge Garry L. Reynolds of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The Stipulation and Order is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 19, at Page 276, and corrects the Decree to clarify the location of the place of use of a water right in the name of W. J. Furnish. This certificate supersedes Certificate 2527.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
