

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIRS 1 AND 3, tributaries of DEVILS LAKE, for IRRIGATING 54.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47281. The date of priority is AUGUST 10, 1982. This right is limited to 3.1 ACRE FEET OF STORED WATER AND 0.68 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 2, T 7 S, R 11 W, W.M.; BEING 130 FEET SOUTH AND 1770 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, from divert flow and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage of water from two reservoirs constructed under Permit R-8553.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


