Tygh Valley , State of . has made proof Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the South Fork of Tygh Creek White River , a tributary of waters of the irrigation of 130.0 acres and , for the purpose of domestic use Permit No. 182 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters in been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1 day of January, 1915 , on the 14th at page 174 the right hereby confirmed dates from November 22, 1909 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 1.63 cubic feet per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use nereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

25 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 9.3 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Section 21; 21.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; 37.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; 9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; 12.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Section 28; all in Township Three (3) South Range Twelve (12) East of Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to die lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
