

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of BOSONBERG CREEK, a tributary of the MALHEUR RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 175.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 48145. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1983. This right is limited to 4.38 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIVERSION 1 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ EAST, W.M.; 90 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, OF SECTION 24;

DIVERSION 2 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ EAST, W.M.; 4980 FEET SOUTH AND 460 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
