

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of BADGER CREEK, and BADGER CREEK, a tributary of MOUNTAIN CREEK, for irrigation of 34.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 47999. The date of priority is AUGUST 22, 1983. This right is limited to 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.82 CFS FROM BADGER CREEK AND 0.03 CFS FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

POD 1 (BADGER CREEK): NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 12 S, R 22 E, W.M.; 2660 FEET SOUTH & 2000 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 32.

POD 2 (UNNAMED STREAM): NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 12 S, R 22 E, W.M.; 280 FEET SOUTH & 780 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 32.

POD 3 (BADGER CREEK): SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 12 S R 22 E, W.M.; 680 FEET NORTH & 700 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


