CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EARNEST O. MEAD
DUFUR, OREGON 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of RAMSEY CREEK, a tributary of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at Page 406. The date of priority is 1867.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed THREE (3.0) ACRE FEET PER ACRE IN ANY IRRIGATION SEASON or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 5656, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 26, 2006, approving Transfer Application 6825.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
