CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK CANTRELL
ROUTE 1, BOX 115
DUFUR, OREGON 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of the WELL #1, within the RAMSEY CREEK BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 44.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6778. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 31, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 430 FEET NORTH AND 3460 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant,
is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 80508, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered June 26, 2006, approving Transfer Application 6825.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
