A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TYLER HANSELL
TRI-SET, Inc.
77432 HOMESTEAD LANE

confirms the right to use the waters of WESTLAND IRRIGATION DISTRICT WASTE AND DRAINAGE, for IRRIGATION OF 6.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27731. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 28, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.; 2020 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ 6.8 ACRES
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion located as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.; 2100 FEET SOUTH AND 270 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 9.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 18, 1981, and together with Transfer T-5610 and Certificate 50169, supersedes Certificate 34485, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
