CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CAT CREEK (ALSO KNOWN AS ALDER CREEK), a tributary of ODELL LAKE, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD.

This right was perfected under Permit 22707. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1953. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 23 S, R 6 E, W.M.; APPROXIMATE LOCATION BY PROJECTION.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
APPROXIMATE LOCATION IN UNSURVEYED AREA AS DETERMINED BY PROJECTION AND FURTHER DESCRIBED AS BEING LOT 3, TRACT E-1, ODELL LAKE RECREATION UNIT.

SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 6 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
