CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF PORTLAND BUREAU OF PARKS 1120 SW 5TH PORTLAND, OREGON 97206

Confirms the right to use the waters of an Unnamed Drainageway, a tributary of Crystal Springs Creek, for IRRIGATION of 98.95 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 30829. The date of priority is August 26, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- DLC 49, SE ¼ SW ¼, Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, W.M.; 5400 FEET NORTH & 1550 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF G. WILLIS DLC #58 and
- DLC 49, NW ¼ NW ¼, Section 24, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, W.M.; 4500 FEET NORTH & 1370 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF G. WILLIS DLC #58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
