THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OLGA WARD and ESTATE of R. A. WARD, PAUL K. and MARTHA J. JACOBS RT 1 BOX 18 HAINES OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 80 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33077. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 27, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.77 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
