 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARTHUR SPADA AND RICHARD SPADA, dba A & R SPADA FARMS  
 7251 ST PAUL HIGHWAY NE  
 ST PAUL, OREGON 97137

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the ROCK CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 21.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10316. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 22, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 61886, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 31, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 68, Page 552, approving a partial cancellation of a water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 61886.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
