

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 76.4 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 115.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41599. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 5.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 5 N, R 35 E, W.M.; BEING 960 FEET NORTH AND 170 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.
