CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SAND HOLLOW CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 7.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4477. The date of priority is DECEMBER 16, 1968. This right is limited to 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 26, T 2 N, R 26 E, W.M., 100 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.7 ACRES

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.7 ACRES

SECTION 26

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The pump system shall include an access port for measuring the water level.


The pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 1987, and together with Certificate 56274, supersedes certificate 50316, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
