CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LLOYD M HILL INC.
RT 4 BOX 55 H
SALEM OR 97302

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2299, tributary to the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 29.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31713. The date of priority is MAY 5, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

8 S	2 W	WM	11	NW NE	41	690 FEET SOUTH AND 1070 FEET EAST FROM THE N1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH cfs per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2299. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 36218, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 20, 2006 approving Transfer Application 9821.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
