CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SWEETHEART SPRING, a tributary of SWEETHEART CREEK and SWEETHEART CREEK, a tributary of BURNT RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41337. The date of priority is JANUARY 20, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE FROM SWEETHEART SPRING, 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK FROM SWEETHEART SPRING, AND 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK FROM SWEETHEART CREEK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.
