CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, DISTRICT OFFICE 3040 BIDDLE ROAD MEDFORD, OREGON 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL within the JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 23.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4488. The date of priority is JANUARY 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
