CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.R. BIGGS PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of DEEP CREEK, a tributary of the OCHOCO CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 80.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Department, in Volume 1, at page 449. The date of priority is 1907.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.33 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND and a reasonable amount for stock and domestic use. The right is further limited to a total quantity not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre during each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 50354, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 27, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 69, Page 170, approving a petition by Ochoco Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes water right Certificate 50354 in the name of W.R. Biggs.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
