CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 50.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits E-192 and E-193. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.63 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other water right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51126, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 27, 2006, and recorded in Special Order Volume 69, Page 170, approving a petition by Ochoco Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with certificate 82260, supersedes water right certificate 51126 in the name of A. A. McCord.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
