

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OLEN D. & FLORENCE A. RAGSDALE

BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAVER CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND GARDEN, AND FIRE PROTECTION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order of Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1869.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be limited to the use of water during the irrigation season, and shall be further limited to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 11 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 480 FEET NORTH
AND 800 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 15.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 4, 1977, approving Transfer Application T-3627, and together with Certificate 30651 supersedes Certificate 30545, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
