CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARGARET LUMPKIN
LAKE CREEK LODGE

confirms the right to use the waters of LAKE CREEK, a tributary of the METOLIUS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by Decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order of Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 13625. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 13 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 2320 FEET SOUTH AND 1120 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 16), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water diverted shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion from the source, which may be diverted at a rate not to exceed ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from May 1 to September 15.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 13 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 2320 FEET SOUTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 15.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ 20.0 ACRES
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on August 22, 1980, approving Transfer Application T-3821, and together with Certificate 49695 supersedes Certificate 13625.
