This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN FORREST ROUTE 2, BOX 920 PRAIRIE CITY, OREGON 97869

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose for IRRIGATION of 17.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461. The date of priority is 1875.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30 and shall be further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; for a diversion of not to exceed five acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: SMALL DITCH: NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 13 S, R 33 E, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 12).

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 13 S, R 33 E, W.M.; 1660 FEET SOUTH AND 980 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 17.0 ACRES SECTION 11 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 8, 1981, and together with certificate 50366, supersedes certificate 24931, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
