CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANNA OLIVER
SPOKANE WA 99210

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 13.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is, 1876. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per season per acre

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 6495, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 13, 2006, approving Transfer Application 10046, and describes the location of the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
