

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAM 1, UNNAMED STREAM 2, AND THE SOUTH FORK MALHEUR RIVER, tributaries of THE MALHEUR RIVER, in ENLARGEMENT OF RESERVOIR 3 AND RESERVOIR 4, appropriated under Permit 49659, for IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10617. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 5, 1986. The amount of water entitled to be stored under this right is 3.5 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR 3 FROM UNNAMED STREAM 2, SUPPLEMENTED FROM THE SOUTH FORK MALHEUR RIVER; AND 6.5 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR 4 FROM UNNAMED STREAM 1, SUPPLEMENTED FROM THE SOUTH FORK MALHEUR RIVER; annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.


