This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of the IRRIGATION OF 13.7 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523. The date of priority is 1902.

The right is limited to not more than 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, OLD MILL DITCH: NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 36 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 470 FEET SOUTH AND 1920 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 4) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 36 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 430 FEET NORTH AND 80 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: Beginning at the quarter section corner common to Sections 9 and 10, T 36 S, R 4 W, W.M., Jackson County, Oregon; thence running North 0° 25' West along the section line 793.3 feet; thence South 75° 30' West 796.0 feet; thence North 10° 00' West 207.5 feet; thence South 76° 00' West 1893.0 feet, more or less, to the North and South center line of said Section 9; thence South along the said North and South center line 340 feet, more or less, to the center of said Section; thence East along the East and West center line of said Section 9, 2640.0 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, the tract containing 23 acres, more or less.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 21, 1982, approving Transfer Application 5007, and supersedes certificate 32800, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
