

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 9.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 51.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10048. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.76 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 22 S, R 30 E, W.M. 9860 FEET NORTH AND 3125 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
