CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 17226. The date of priority is August 5, 1946. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

POD # 1: NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 10 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 1750 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 31.

POD # 2: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 10 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 300 FEET NORTH AND 750 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of

not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during ANY MONTH AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A TOTAL DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 5.0 ACRE-FEET DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF April 1 to September 20 of each year.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4	5.3 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.4 ACRES
LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)	0.2 ACRE
SECTION 31	
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.	

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 7, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5172, and together with certificate 51514, supersedes Certificate 46260, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
